- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with fellow employees, officials and the public.
- Perform fire-fighting activities, including operating pumps and related equipment, laying hose and performing fire combat, containment and extinguishment tasks.
- Maintain and safely operate equipment.
- Perform general maintenance work in the upkeep of fire facilities and grounds.
- Operate radio and other communication equipment.
- Perform salvage operations such as throwing salvage covers, sweeping water and removing debris.
- Perform inspections of buildings and property within the city for possible fire hazards and for fire safety regulations.

This is an entry level position, no previous experience is required, some experience is preferred. Completion of high school level education or G.E.D. Certification requirements: NIMS 100, 200, 700, 800. Must possess a valid Kansas Class C driver's license. Must be at least 18 years of age at time of appointment. Firefighter I is required within one year of employment.
